


## .. Kangwon National University (KNU)

Kangwon National University (KNU), boasting of its 70—year history as one of ten core national universities in the Republic of Korea, has been making sincere efforts to respond to the rapidly—changing global era. KNU's main campus is located in Chuncheon, the capital city of Gangwon province, and has 115 departments in both undergraduate and graduate programs. KNU has more than 22,000 students in undergraduate and graduate programs, including 1,130 international students (April, 2019). KNU has more than 2,500 academic faculty members including 987 full—time members.

Particularly, KNU has been actively participating in various international development cooperation activities with many developing countries. As a regional stronghold university, KNU has also been endeavoring to concentrate creative ideas and resources on local communities and the regional industries.

## :. HEAT Program

As a scholarship program sponsored by the Korean Government, Higher Education for ASEAN Talents (HEAT) aims to provide higher education opportunities to faculty members of ASEAN countries. Particularly, HEAT invites faculty members who hold a master's degree and wish to acquire a doctoral degree in order to enhance their knowledge and expertise in their research fields.

The Korean Council for University Education (KCUE) is the implementing agency of the HEAT project. KCUE is a non-profit, non-governmental association of 4-year universities. Not only does it provide a voice for the member universities, but it also increases autonomy while promoting mutual cooperation among the individual universities for the sound development of higher education in Korea.

## :. Total Number of Grantees: 5 faculty members from ASEAN countries (per year)

## . Applicant Requirements

- Applicants must 1) hold citizenship in one of the ASEAN countries and 2) currently be a full—time faculty member
  of a university in his/her home country.
- O Applicants must possess a master's degree or its equivalent as the highest level of educational attainment.
- O The applicant should be able to obtain a study leave from his/her university for three years and should return to his/university upon obtaining a Ph.D. degree at KNU.

## :. Scholarship

O Scholarship Period: 3 years of doctoral program

O Benefits:

- Airfare (one time only): Round-trip economy class ticket.

- Monthly Allowance: USD 1,100 per month.

- Relocation (Settlement) Allowance (one time only): USD 300 upon arrival

- Tuitions: All tuition fees are waived by the host institution.

- Dissertation Printing Costs: USD 400  $\sim$  600, depending on the actual costs.

### :. Curriculum and Selective Courses

- Requirements to acquire a Ph.D. degree: 1) 30 credits of courses 2) qualifying exam 3)
   publication of at least one paper in an academic journal, 4) presentation of at least one paper in an international conference, and 5) dissertation.
- O Selective Courses (3 credits each)

#### 1) KNU-KOICA Scholarship Program in Global Agricultural Economics

This scholarship program is a Master's Degree Program in Agricultural Economics, financially supported by Korea International Cooperation Agency (KOICA). The KNU–KOICA scholarship program invites public servants and professionals from developing countries for a Master's degree program in the field of global agricultural economics. Participants are expected to strengthen the knowledge and policy analysis capabilities of the agricultural economy through lecture, field learning, and thesis guidance. The program aims to create a workforce that can increase agricultural production by leading agricultural development in the country.

#### 2) KNU-AIMS (Asian International Mobility for Students) Program

Through this program, we exchange undergraduate students with partner universities in ASEAN countries, focusing on the area of international trade. Specifically, this program aims to cultivate global talents who can understand diverse culture, histories, and societies of participating countries as well as develop their expertise in the economic and business environments of their respective countries. KNU-AIMS program has partner universities in Malaysia, Indonesia, Thailand and Vietnam and receive a total of ten students from partner universities while sending 10+ students to partner universities.
